*The status of SC/ST for Category 3 (candidates shall be only for relaxation of educational qualification. Allotment of seat will be on the basis of OPEN AIR rank of JEE (Main) 2021

Un-Reserved Seats means Seats open for Indigenous ST of Nagaland i.e.85% of total seats. Reserved Seats means Seats that are being reserved for category 2 candidates' i.e. 15% of total seats.

Horizontal reservation which is to be taken from the vertical reservation above (if any candidates available in the respective category) is as given below:

Differently abled (PWD) = 5 % seat

Seat Availability and Sequence of Seat Allotment 11.4.4

- Rule 1 All candidates from Category- 1 and Category- 2 are eligible for seat allocation in order of merit in un-reserved seats.
- Rule 2 In every discipline (eg. Civil, Mechanical, computer Science & Engineering (etc) only 1 (one) seat per tribe will be allotted in order of merit for the Reserved seats. i.e. Category - 2 candidates
- Rule 3 If any vacancy seat arise from Reserved seats under any category after completion of round 1 and round 2. The vacant seats would still be filled up as per rule 1 and 2. Even after applying such relaxation during spot round, if the seat still remain vacant, the reserved seats would be de-reserved during the spot round counseling and the vacant seats would be allotted to category 1 or category 2 based on the JEE (main) merit during the spot round counseling.
- Rule 4 If any seats remains unfilled even after applying rule 3. The seat would be would be offered to category 3 candidates based on JEE (main) merit during the spot round.



11.4.5 Other instructions

- State domicile declaration to be obtained while registration
- Status of PWD candidate is to be captured at the time of registration
- Gender to be captured during registration since there are some exclusive girls colleges / seats
- The seats under CSAB-NEUT are allotted to the State of Nagaland by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource, New Delhi. Candidates are advised to check the eligibility criteria of each Institute along with branch before filling online choice exercise. It is to be iterated that the eligibility criteria and fee structure varies from Institute to Institute across the States.
- The seat matrix is made available in the official website of CSAB-NEUT or the official website of Directorate of Technical Education (dtenagaland.org.in).

Eligibility Criteria:

- Category 1 Members of recognized Indigenous Scheduled Tribes of Nagaland as notified by the Government from time to time (As table I).
- Category 2 Members of recognized Backward Tribes (BT) of Nagaland as notified by the Government from time to time (As table II).

Category - 3

- a. Candidates belonging to the non-local Indigenous Inhabitants of Nagaland as per P&AR Department Notification No. AR-8/8/76 dated 28th April,1977.
- b. Children of Non-Local State Government employees and children of All India Service Officers borne on Nagaland Cadre. To be eligible under Category3(b), the candidate should have appeared/passed class X/XII or equivalent from any of the schools within Nagaland and his/her parent(s) should have been residing and posted in Nagaland for at least 3(three) years or more. Both the criteria should befulfilled.
